

St Michael's Catholic School UNIFORM POLICY

RATIONALE

St Michael's Catholic School support the wearing of a school uniform in order tohelp fulfil the aims of the school, in particular those listed below:

- To be a Catholic community recognised by our love of God and of our neighbour
- To value and respect ourselves and all others.

We believe wearing a uniform:

- Promotes equality of opportunity for all pupils, social cohesion amongst pupils and protection from social pressure to dress in a particular way.
- Helps give the pupils of the school a sense of identity, belonging and positive self-image
- Gives the school a well-respected profile and supports its Catholic, Christian ethos
- Creates a culture of high expectations and high achievement within the school;

PROVISIONS

- a) All pupils from Nursery to Key Stage 5 are required to wear full school uniform.
- b) The uniform is designed to be acceptable to pupils, parents and staff and to be suitable (in terms of safety and comfort) for the range of activities pupils enjoy at school.
- c) The uniform list is published on the school website and in information sent out to new parents. Reminders about the uniform details are sent out to all pupils at least once a year. Items are priced competitively and the overall cost of the school uniform is kept low.
- d) Occasionally, changes are made in consultation with the students, parents and staff.
- e) The Sixth Form are required to wear smart office attire to school, including a shirt and tie for the boys.
- f) Requests for reasonable adjustments to uniform to meet the needs of individual pupils, e.g. for medical or religious reasons, will be carefully considered. However, in adopting this policy the governors have taken all possible steps to ensure that it is fair and reasonable, is non-discriminatory and acceptable to the majority.

Please note that no other retailer has been approve to sell badged items of uniform. The uniform is non-negotiable and parents are expected to support the school by ensuring their children are wearing the correct uniform. The Headteacher can discipline your child for not wearing the school uniform and they can be removed from lessons, suspended or expelled from school if they repeatedly ignore the uniform policy.

MONITORING

- a) Pupils not meeting expectations regarding uniform will be challenged. Where there are extenuating circumstances, the school will give support the student in any way possible to address the issue and resolve the situation.
- b) All staff are involved in monitoring the standard of school uniform. Uniform forms part of the Pupil Non-Negotiables which outline expected standards. All staff have a responsibility to check uniform and follow up any breaches.
- c) As a school we carry out daily uniform checks in registration, and uniform is monitored throughout the day in lessons and during break and lunch.
- d) If a secondary phase pupil persistently fails to meet the requirements of the uniform policy and parents do not respond appropriately to the issues raised, the pupil will be removed from lessons and wwork in the Reflection Room whilst in school until an agreed solution is reached.
- e) If a primary phase pupil persistently fails to meet the requirements of the uniform policy and parents do not respond appropriately to the issues raised, a meeting will be held between the parents and the class teacher to ascertain why the uniform policy cannot be adhered to and what solutions can be put in place.
